**Prayer of Praise and Confession** Darcy Evans  
From 1 Chronicles 16:28-36, "David's Song of Thanks."

Reader: Ascribe to the Lord, O families of the peoples,

**All: ascribe to the Lord glory and strength!**

Reader: Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name; bring an  
offering and come before him!

**All: Worship the Lord in the splendor of holiness;**

Reader: tremble before him, all the earth; yes, the world is  
established; it shall never be moved. Let the heavens be glad,  
and let the earth rejoice, and let them say among the nations,

**All: "The Lord reigns!"**

Reader: Let the sea roar, and all that fills it; let the field exult,  
and everything in it! Then shall the trees of the forest sing for  
joy before the Lord, for he comes to judge the earth.

**Affirmation of Faith** The Heidelberg Catechism (1562)

Q. 21. What is true faith?

**A. It is not only a certain knowledge by which I accept as  
true all that God has revealed to us in his Word, but also a  
wholehearted trust which the Holy Spirit creates in me  
through the gospel, that, not only to others, but to me also  
God has given the forgiveness of sins, everlasting righteous-  
ness and salvation, out of sheer grace solely for the sake of  
Christ's saving work.**

Q. 22. What, then, must a Christian believe?

**A. All that is promised us in the gospel, a summary of which  
is taught us in the articles of the Apostles' Creed, our univer-  
sally acknowledged confession of faith.**

Q. 23. What are these articles?

**A. I believe in God the Father Almighty,  
Maker of Heaven and earth; And in Jesus Christ, his only-  
begotten Son, our Lord; who was conceived by the Holy  
Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary; suffered under Pontius  
Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried; he descended  
into hell; the third day he rose again from the dead;**

**He ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of  
God the Father Almighty; from thence he shall come to  
judge the living and the dead.**

**I believe in the Holy Spirit; the holy catholic Church; the  
communion of saints; the forgiveness of sins; the resur-  
rection of the body; and the life everlasting. Amen.**

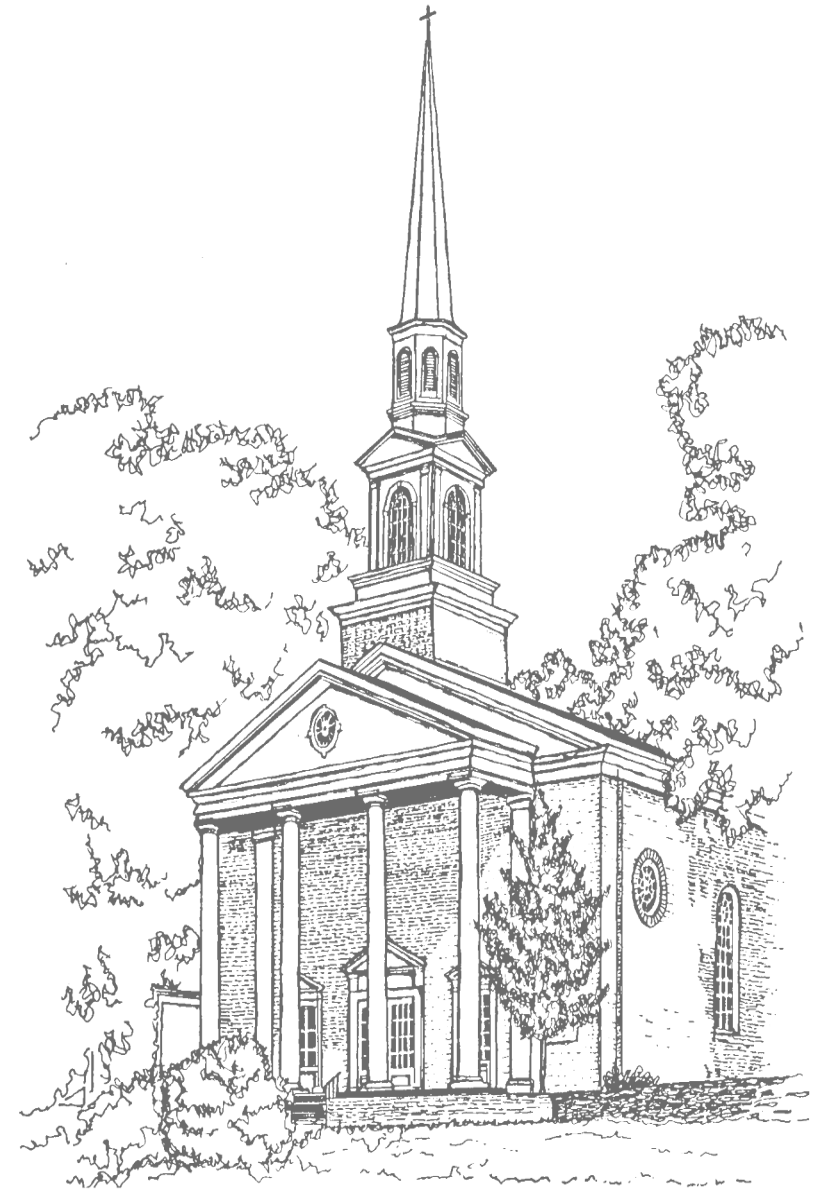
