THE ANNUAL MEETINGS of Lenoir Presbyterian Church and LPC, Inc. are called by the Session and the Board of Trustees for Sunday, February 3, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. in the Sanctuary. The nursery is available all Sunday morning. Part of our business will be to vote on a proposal from the Officer Nominating Committee. The ONC believes a smaller session will serve the needs of the congregation well and reflect better the size of our congregation and pool of elders. It recommends to the congregation: *That the congregation elect 5 elders and 5 deacons for the class of 2021, but only 4 elders beginning with the election of the class of 2022, and continuing with all Session classes thereafter, thus reducing by the class of 2024 the Session to 13 members (12 elders and pastor) while maintaining the Diaconate at 15 members.*

The Session has unanimously concurred with this recommendation.

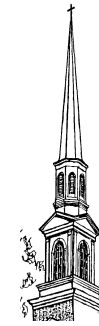
